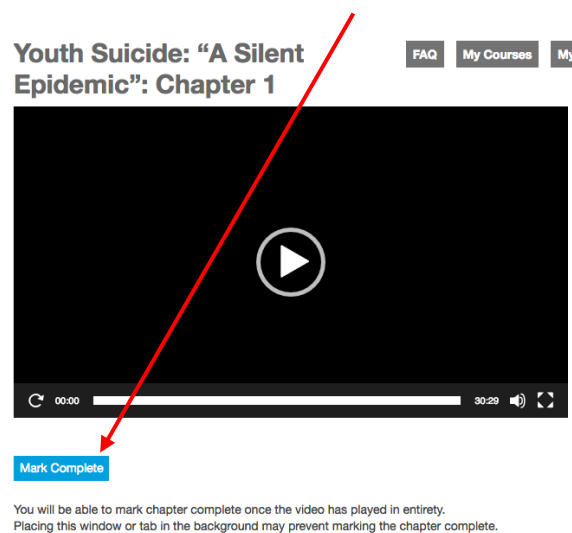

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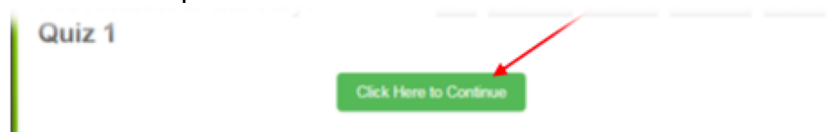

Take the quiz that follows the chapter video. Click **Check** to see if the answer is correct.




Continue watching all the videos and taking all the quizzes in Module 5. Click the **Click Here to Continue** button after each quiz.
