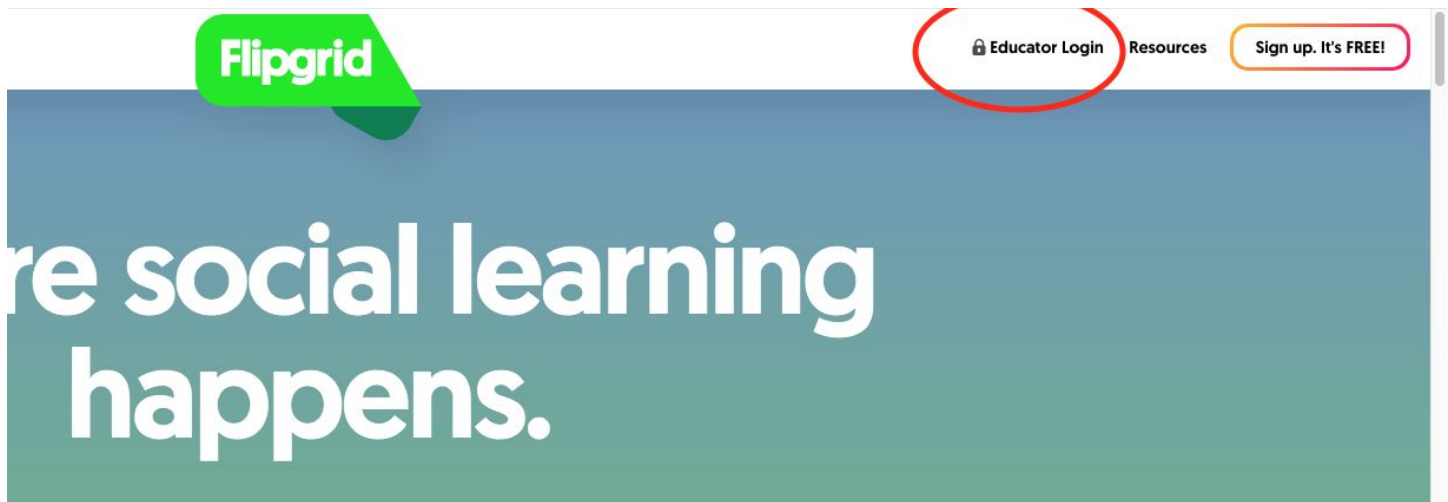


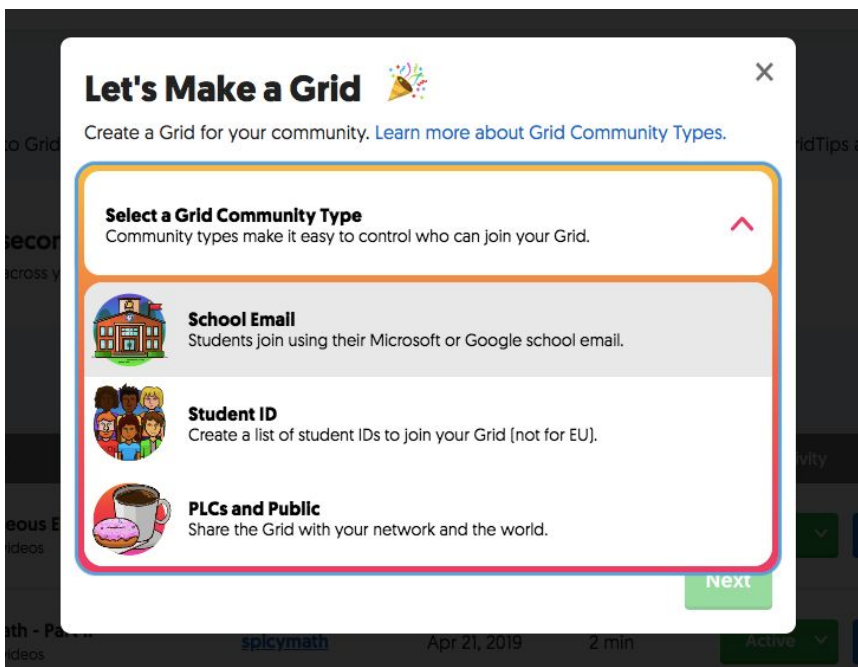
FlipGrid How To



First go to <https://flipgrid.com/>
Click on **Educator Log In**



Sign in with **Google (school) account**. (email + active directory password)



You will need to choose an audience – do you want to create a Grid for your students to access or your PLC group?

***When creating a FlipGrid for students, I always choose the top one**

– School Email.

You will put student.knoxschools.org and knoxschools.org so that only students and teachers connected to Knox County can join your Grid.

You will be prompted to Make a Grid. You should think of a Grid as a Class. What are the names of your classes? That's what I would name my grids.

Examples: English 12CP, Science 6, Math 7Hon

Things to consider:

Ask yourself, in what kinds of situations do I want students to have discussions they share with me? Their classmates? Do I want everyone who has the FlipGrid Code to be able to read what others have posted? Do I want to get an email when students post videos to the Topic? Do I want students to receive emails when a new video is posted?

Features

Notify Me

Receive an email notification when new student videos are added to Topics in this Grid.



Allow Downloads

Allow students to download their videos after creating a Response.



Grid Followers

Allow students to receive email notifications when new Topics are created and new videos recorded.



Captions

Display auto-generated captions. For best results, videos should be recorded in an environment with little ambient noise.



Active State

Make your Grid active or hidden. Hidden Grids will not be accessible to your students.

Select a language to be used to process your captions.

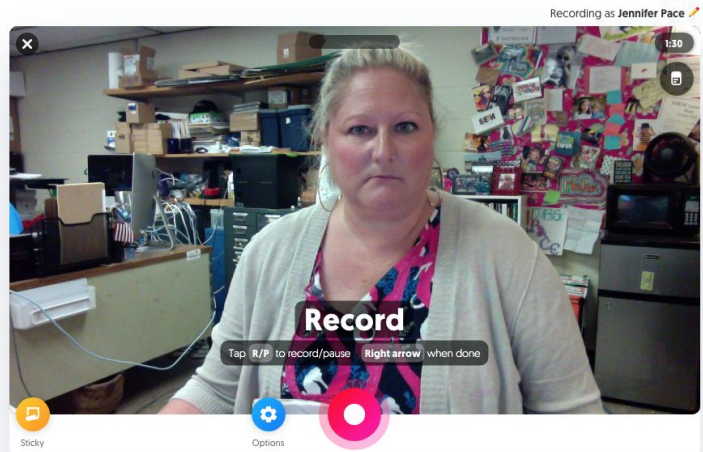
